





Contribute.....



- UN GGIM: platform for effective strategies on how to build and strengthen national capacity on geospatial information, and
- Includes an <u>expert group on land</u> <u>administration and management</u>



- FFP: There is an urgent need to build systems to provide security of tenure & control of the use of land.
- When building such systems the focus should be on a "fit-for-purpose approach" that will meet the needs of society today and can be incrementally improved over time


