Geospatial and Survey professionals are contributing to the measurement and monitoring of the United Nations (UN) Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

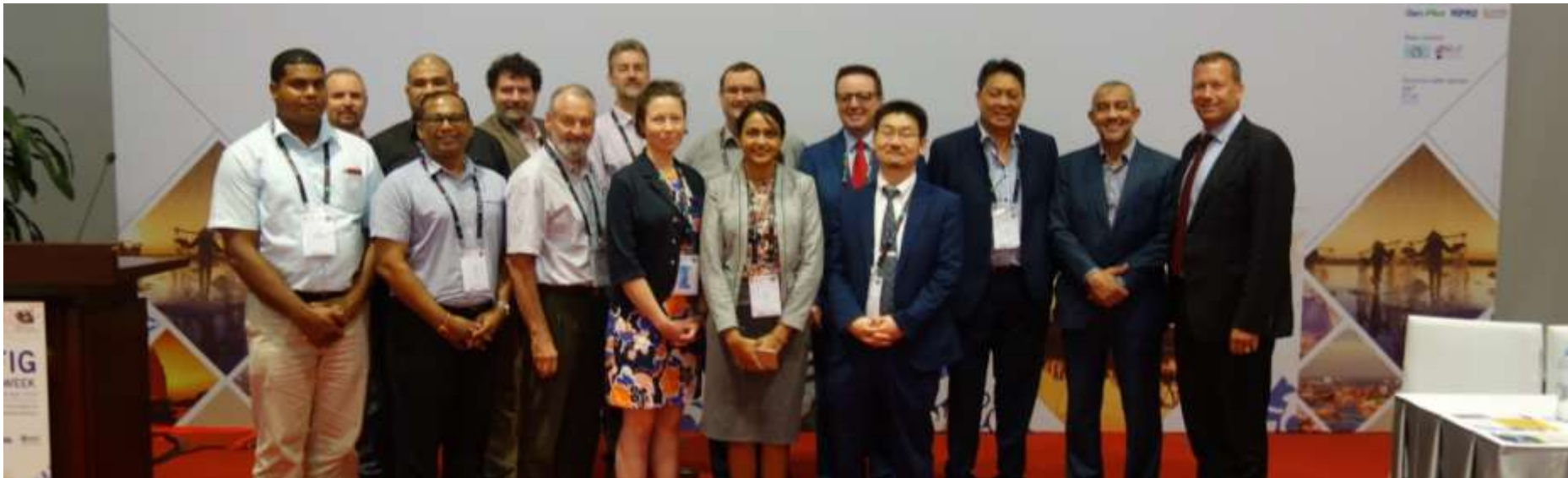
